

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE KEIM STREET SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION TO CREST CONSTRUCTION GROUP BASED ON THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BID

WHEREAS, the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority (the "Authority"), a duly constituted public body in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, has determined that there is a need to extend the sanitary sewer system to two (2) properties located on Keim Street, as further specified in the bid package ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, through a fair and open process, the Authority prepared the bid package and solicited bids for the Contract, to be opened publicly and announced at the offices of the Authority on January 22, 2020 at 10:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer reviewed the bid documents and made recommendations to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the award of the contract is conditioned upon the approval of the homeowners; and


WHEREAS, the Authority determined that the lowest responsible bidder is Crest Construction Group based on the lowest base bid.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon proper motion and vote at a public meeting by the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The award of the contract herein is conditioned upon the written approval and contribution of the project costs by both homeowners located at 420 and 502 Keim Street.
2. Crest Construction Group is deemed to be the lowest responsible bidder for the Contract. It is deemed to be in the best interests of the Authority to waive any nonmaterial irregularities which may appear in the submission.
3. Upon written approval by each homeowner, the Executive Director is therefore authorized to execute a written agreement with Crest Construction Group in a form approved by the Solicitor and consistent with the bid package/submission.
4. The Executive Director is authorized to execute other documents as necessary to facilitate and complete the Contract.
5. The Contract Award is contingent on the Authority's Chief Financial Officer's Certification that there exist sufficient appropriated funds for the Contract.
