

EDGEWATER PARK SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR TVING OF SANITARY SEWER LINES TO DIVERSIFIED INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,839.25 BASED UPON THEIR PROPOSAL LETTER

WHEREAS, the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority, a duly constituted public body in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey ("Authority"), has determined that there is a need to obtain TVing of the sanitary sewer lines in anticipation of paving projects, as further specified in the bid package ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer, Environmental Resolutions, Inc., received a proposal from Diversified Infrastructure Services, Inc., to provide this service for payment in an amount not to exceed \$18,839.25, which proposal is incorporated by reference here as if set forth at length; and

WHEREAS, the Authority finds that is appropriate to award the contract to Diversified Infrastructure Services, Inc. based on the firm's professional experience and expertise.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon proper motion and vote at a public meeting by the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Authority's Executive Director is authorized to enter into a contract with Diversified Infrastructure Services, Inc. for the TVing of the sanitary sewer lines in anticipation of paving projects, which contract shall be in a form approved by the Authority Solicitor ("Agreement"). The total payment for services under the Agreement shall not exceed \$18,839.25.
2. The Agreement is contingent on the Authority's Chief Financial Officer's Certification that there are sufficient funds to pay for the Agreement.
3. The Authority shall publish a brief notice stating the nature, duration, service, and amount of the Agreement, and that the Resolution and Agreement are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Authority.
4. The Authority's Officers and Professionals are authorized to take actions necessary to achieve the purposes of this Resolution.


