- 1. The Authority authorizes the award of the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority Roosevelt Park sewer improvements to Coastline Construction, LLC in an amount of \$432,550.00;
- 2. This award is contingent on the Authority's Chief Financial Officer's Certification that there exist sufficient and appropriated funds for the purchase and is within the budget;

RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NUMBER TWO FOR SANITARY ROOT TREATMENT AND POINT REPAIR CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority, a duly constituted public body in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey ("Authority");

WHEREAS, the Authority has entered into an agreement with Mobile Dredging and Video Pipe Inc., which is the "Sanitary Sewer Root Treatment and Point Repair Contract";

WHEREAS, a Change Order was presented by Mobile Dredging and Video Pipe Inc., in the amount of \$1,425.00 for Heavy Cleaning/Root Cutting, removing from the contract a section of trenchless point repair and for a 60 day extension of the contract;

WHEREAS, removing from the contract the section of trenchless point repair reduces the contract amount by \$1450.00 thus causing a net reduction of the total contract amount to \$24, 592.05; and
