**RESOLUTION AWARDING THE PUMP STATION #3 UPGRADE CONTRACT TO
DEMAIO ELECTRICAL COMPANY INCORPORATED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,169,800.00)**

WHEREAS, the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority, a duly constituted public body in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey (“Authority”);

WHEREAS, the Authority recognizes the need to secure a contractor to complete the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system;

WHEREAS, the Authority has sought bids for the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system;

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Engineer has reviewed the bids received for the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system;

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Engineer recommends awarding the contract for the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system to DeMaio Electrical Company, Inc. in an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,169,800.00) and;

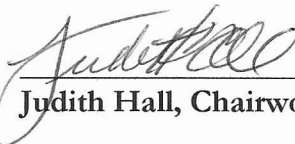
WHEREAS, the Authority desires to approve the Engineer’s recommendation and award the contract for the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system to DeMaio Electrical Company, Inc. in an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,169,800.00);

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon proper motion and vote at a public meeting by the Edgewater Park Sewerage Authority in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Awarding the contract for the upgrades to Pump Station #3 of the sanitary sewer system to DeMaio Electrical Company, Inc. in an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,169,800.00) is hereby **ADOPTED** by this Resolution on August 13, 2025;
2. This approval shall be subject to certification of availability of funds to pay for this work.
